- 1. This Rule 10b5-1 plan provides for fixed sales of a total of up to 300,000 shares of stock options and Class A Common Stock through January 2022.
- 2. The price reported in Column 4 is a weighted-average price. The price actually received ranges from \$148.98 to \$149.97. For all transactions reported in this Form 4 utilizing a weighted-average price, the Reporting Person undertakes to provide upon request by the SEC staff, the issuer, or a security holder of the issuer, full information regarding the number of shares sold at each separate price within the range.
- 3. The price reported in Column 4 is a weighted-average price. The price actually received ranges from \$149.98 to \$150.96. For all transactions reported in this Form 4 utilizing a weighted-average price, the Reporting Person undertakes to provide upon request by the SEC staff, the issuer, or a security holder of the issuer, full information regarding the number of shares sold at each separate price within the range.
- 4. The price reported in Column 4 is a weighted-average price. The price actually received ranges from \$150.99 to \$151.98. For all transactions reported in this Form 4 utilizing a weighted-average price, the Reporting Person undertakes to provide upon request by the SEC staff, the issuer, or a security holder of the issuer, full information regarding the number of shares sold at each separate price within the range.
- 5. The price reported in Column 4 is a weighted-average price. The price actually received ranges from \$152.03 to \$152.16. For all transactions reported in this Form 4 utilizing a weighted-average price, the Reporting Person undertakes to provide upon request by the SEC staff, the issuer, or a security holder of the issuer, full information regarding the number of shares sold at each separate price within the range.
- 6. Each share of Class B Common Stock is convertible, at any time at the election of the holder, into one share of Class A Common Stock. In addition, each share of Class B Common Stock will convert automatically into one share of Class A Common Stock upon (i) the date specified by the holders of at least 66 2/3% of the outstanding shares of Class B Common Stock, (ii) any transfer, except for certain "qualified transfers" (as defined in the Issuer's Certificate of Incorporation) or (iii) upon the death of a natural person holding shares of Class B Common Stock (subject to certain exceptions as defined in the Issuer's Certificate of Incorporation).
- 7. Granted pursuant to the 2014 Equity Incentive Plan.
- 8. Vests in three equal annual installments commencing on the first anniversary of the grant date.
- 9. Granted pursuant to 2009 Unit Incentive Plan.
- 10. Vests as to 25% of the shares on the first anniversary of the grant date and as to 6.25% of the shares at the end of each three-month period thereafter.
